A Bit about the 2021 Project

- This year we are pleased to be partnering with the Flin Flon Public Library
- The mural will be on the South wall (facing the Post Office)
- The wall is red brick with three feet of stucco on the bottom
- Please see the diagram and dimensions below for the scale of the mural

Flin Flon Public Library Mural Design Template



South facing wall elevation:

Top Section - Brick - 48'6" wide x 15' tall

Bottom Section - stucco - 48'6" x 3' tall

Scale figure - 6' tall

Designers are encouraged to visit the site to assess specific design considerations themselves.

The theme for the mural can include (but is not limited to):

- History of the area
- Reading & literacy
- Books
- Archives
- Indigenous history
- Discovery of the original ore body
- Historic figures in our area
- A combination of some or all the above

If you are submitting a mural design, please follow these guidelines:

- The design must be created to scale and include correct proportions (see above for dimensions of the wall).
- A design must be submitted with this form and should be in JPEG, PNG, or PDF format.

The sky's the limit with this project and we are not committed to any structure in terms of the number of artists or how each person is involved. We want to work with the successful artist(s) to create an experience that works best for them. Part of our mandate is to provide artist mentorship opportunities within our community so this will be taken into consideration when selecting the artist(s).

Processes and Timelines

- All applications will be reviewed by an adjudication board.
- Applicants selected for the short-list will be contacted in late April to discuss artist fees, work plan and timelines, mentorship opportunities, and potential partnerships.
- Once the design and artist(s) have been chosen, a contract will be drafted and the work plan finalized.
- The goal is to start preparing the wall on or around June 4, 2021 with painting of the mural starting as soon as preparation is complete.
- We hope to have the mural done as early as possible in the summer, but we understand weather can be a factor so the projected completion date is August 31, 2021.
